### Enjoy fun, festive holiday cards and ornaments and help support KCC!



# Festive Crinkle Cookies

It's the most wonderful time of the year... CHRISTMAS COOKIE SEASON! And these festive Crinkle cookies definitely won't disappoint! Also, they are super fun and easy, meaning they are great for making with some little hands that want to help!

#### Ingredients

- White Cake Mix
- 2 Eggs
- 1/3 cup oil
- 1/3 cup powdered sugar
- Red and green food colouring



#### **Directions:**

- Mix eggs, oil and cake mix in a large bowl, it should have a play-doh like consistency.
- Separate dough into two equal amounts.
- In small bowls, dye one part red and the other part green.
- Refrigerate dough for 30 minutes to create fluffier cookies.
- Roll tablespoon-size balls of dough in powdered sugar and place them on a parchment-lined cookie sheet.
- Bake for 9-11 minutes at 375 degrees.
